

## THE WRONG JESUS » “DON’T ASK” JESUS

1. People with (honest questions) are right at home with (Jesus). (Matt 13:10-13)

(Students) get farther than (skeptics).

Go to the (source).

Don’t ask (alone).

» Our honest questions are our (greatest opportunity) to really know Jesus.

### **Do this:**

Identify the questions you are asking of life and Jesus. What are you going to do with your questions?

» When we have questions... (press on). (Phil 3:12-14)

2. People with (honest questions) should be right at home with (us). (Phil 3:15-17)

Point people to (trust in God).

Questions are not (setbacks), they are (opportunities).

Pursue answers with those who are (pursuing answers).

### **Do this:**

1. Finish identifying questions and make a plan for giving God space to give you answers, peace, or both.

2. Choose a gospel. Read through paying attention to how Jesus responds to people with different kinds of questions.

3. Have 3 conversations this week with different people about their questions about Jesus. DON’T answer them. Join them as they explore their questions.
